5.1. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MoU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.

5.2. Any divergence or difference derived from the interpretation or application of the MoU shall be resolved by arbitration between the parties as per the Arbitration Act, 1996. The place of the arbitration shall be at District Head Quarters of the First Party. This undertaking is to be construed in accordance with Indian Law with exclusive jurisdiction in the Courts of **Madurai**.



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



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

The Memorandum of Understanding is entered between **SOURASHTRA COLLEGE (AUTONOMOUS)**, having its office Villachery Main Road, Pasumalai (Post), Madurai-625004 hereinafter referred to as the 'Institution 1'.

AND

JB HYDRAULICS, having its office Shed No:5, SIDCO Industrial estate, K.Pudur, MADURAI-625007 hereinafter referred to as the 'Institution 2'.

Whereas the 'Institution 1' engages in offering various Under Graduate, Post Graduate and Research Programmes under Madurai Kamaraj University.

Whereas the 'Institution 2' engages in manufacturing hydraulic presses and other rubber processing machines.

PURPOSE OF MOU

In particular, this MOU is intended to

1. Enhance entrepreneurial mindsets among the student's community of Sourashtra College
2. Organize various workshops on Entrepreneurship Development
3. Conduct practical trainings on Entrepreneurship Development
4. Conduct training programmes on Accounts Maintenance
5. Conduct training programmes on Production Management
6. Conduct training programmes on Logistics and Skill matrix of labours
5. Generate self-employment opportunities
6. Assist the students in establishing various start-ups
7. Arrange the placement of trained students.

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

CLAUSE 1 CO-OPERATION

1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the **Institution** and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure

additional opportunities for one another.

1.2 First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of First Party providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable teaching / training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the industry, the Second Party.

1.3 The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MOU. The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents (the 'Definitive Documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU. The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.

CLAUSE 2

SCOPE OF THE MoU

2.1 The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in technological up-gradation, innovation and competitiveness of an industry. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.

2.2 **Curriculum Design:** Second Party will give valuable inputs to the First Party in teaching / training methodology and suitably customize the curriculum so that the students fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully.
