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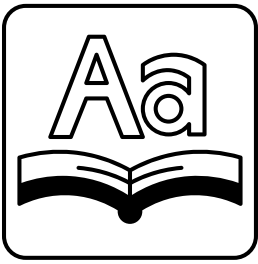

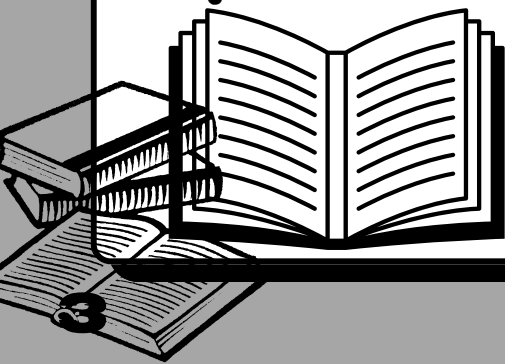


PG & RESEARCH DEPARTMENT OF ENGLISH

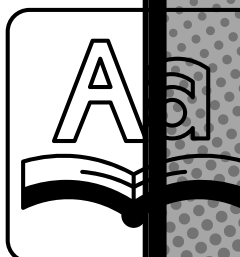
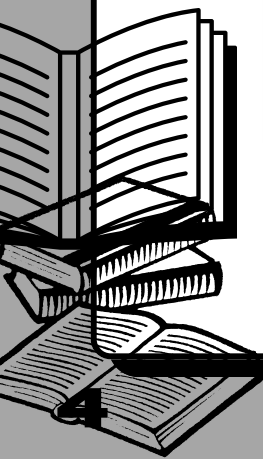

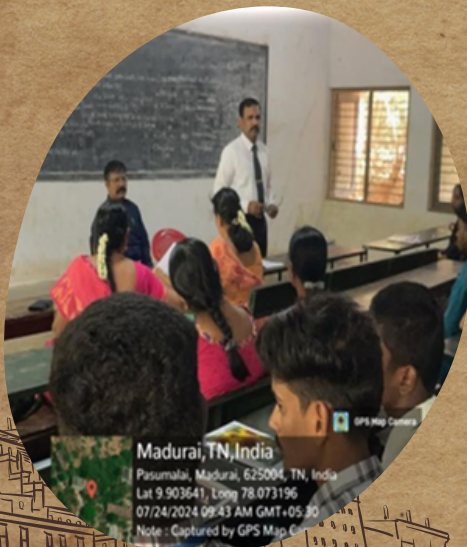

Our students actively participated in various competitions conducted by other colleges in and around Madurai.

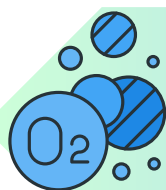
