MINUTES OF THE MEETING

- The meeting started with the prayer by Dr.M.R.Rashila.
- Dr. V.K.Vijayakumar, Dean, Academic Affairs, welcomed the gathering. He expressed
 his deep gratitude for the sincere effort taken by the staff members in framing the syllabus
 and also for the kind cooperation extended by them. He thanked the Management for
 providing a very good infrastructure to the staff and students.
- The Chairman and the Principal Dr. L.P. Ramalingam, place on record the following significant activities held during this academic year 2018-19.

More than 25 guest lectures were arranged by various departments on various topics. In addition, 5 national seminars were conducted during this year. The Dept. of English in association with Root Journal has organized a one day International Conference during Feb. 2019. The Department of Commerce and Research Centre has conducted 2 Ph.D. Viva Voce during this year.

Our college Basket Ball Player Mr. L. Manikandan has been awarded Rs.50,000/-from the Chief Minister for his sports achievement. 18 students of our college selected by various companies through placement drive.

The UGC has released an Autonomy Grant of Rs.16 lakhs for the year 2018-19 and all accounts relating to UGC were settled down to the year 2017-18. The construction work in respect the UGC Fitness Centre with Science Back has been fully completed.

Our college has registered for the NIRF (National Institutional Ranking Framework) India Ranking 2019 under the college level ranking category in the online portal and successfully uploaded the required data. Further, the data relating to All Indian Survey for Higher Education (AISHE) was also successfully uploaded during Feb. 2019.

The NAAC Peer Team Visit for 3rd cycle of Accreditation has been successfully completed on 27.03.2019 and awarded 'B+' grade by the NAAC with a score of 2.74 out of 4.

- The Chairman of B.A.(Tamil) placed the syllabi for I year before the Academic Council for ratification.
